XSJN seeks to engage the wider Xavier College community in becoming compassionate and reflective men & women who are committed to serving those in need through direct service & through raising awareness of social justice issues.

Volunteering

XSJN invites the Xavier College community to engage in volunteer work with social services agencies which support vulnerable people. The agencies are chosen carefully to ensure that they operate in line with our XSJN mission & values.

XSJN partner agencies & their volunteer programs include:



- Jesuit Social Services—we respond as needed to the diverse programs offered by JSS
- Sacred Heart Mission Preparing & serving meals in the Dining Room. Offering friendship to women attending the Women's House
- St Vincent de Paul Society Preparing & serving meals on the Soup Van Program or at the Friday Night BBQ
- Brigidine Asylum Seekers Project Offering friendship & support to refugees & asylum seekers through the English Teaching Program
- River Nile School Supporting disadvantaged refugee & asylum seeker women enrolled in the English Language Program
- Education First Youth Foyers Provide mentoring to young people at risk of homelessness
- Free to Feed Cooking School Assistant with Asylum Seekers
- St Mary's House of Welcome Preparing & serving meals to vulnerable people attending the Dining Hall
- AMEP Tutoring CALD adults through the Volunteer Tutor Scheme
- Refugee Legal Migration Agents & Paralegal Support
- The Haven Providing friendship & support to residents through the Companionship Program
- Wellspring for Women—Providing support to programs for vulnerable & isolated women


